#### Mahidol University

Mahidol University has a long and proud history of contributing to knowledge development in Thailand and is committed to research and teaching excellence. The establishment of Siriraj Hospital in 1888 by His Majesty King Chulalongkorn set the foundation for creation of the University of Medical Sciences in 1943, which was officially renamed as Mahidol University by His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej in 1969. Since then, Mahidol University has gained a reputation as being one of the nation's most prestigious higher learning institutes, forging many global collaborative links to build on its core strengths in medicine, health, and science related areas and open new opportunities for innovation in research and higher learning.



#### Mahidol University Kanchanaburi Campus

Mahidol University established the Kanchanaburi Campus in western Thailand in mid-2002 with the main objective of expanding higher education into the upcountry regions, so as to increase local incomes, create occupational opportunities and improve the quality of life of the rural people. The climate is tropical otherwise moderately pleasant throughout the year with temperature varying from 20 °C to 38 °C and with some showers from July to September.
